 - 53 historic buildings
 - 1 historic site (Montezuma Ave.)
 - 1 archaeological site (Hawkins Preserve)
 - 4 historic signs
 - 3 National Register properties
- Criteria for Listing
- Benefits of Listing
 - state & fed tax credits to property owners
- Apply by May 14
